Executive Summary

AURIX is a destination intelligence and monetization infrastructure platform designed for tourism authorities, districts, malls, hospitality groups, and large-scale venues.

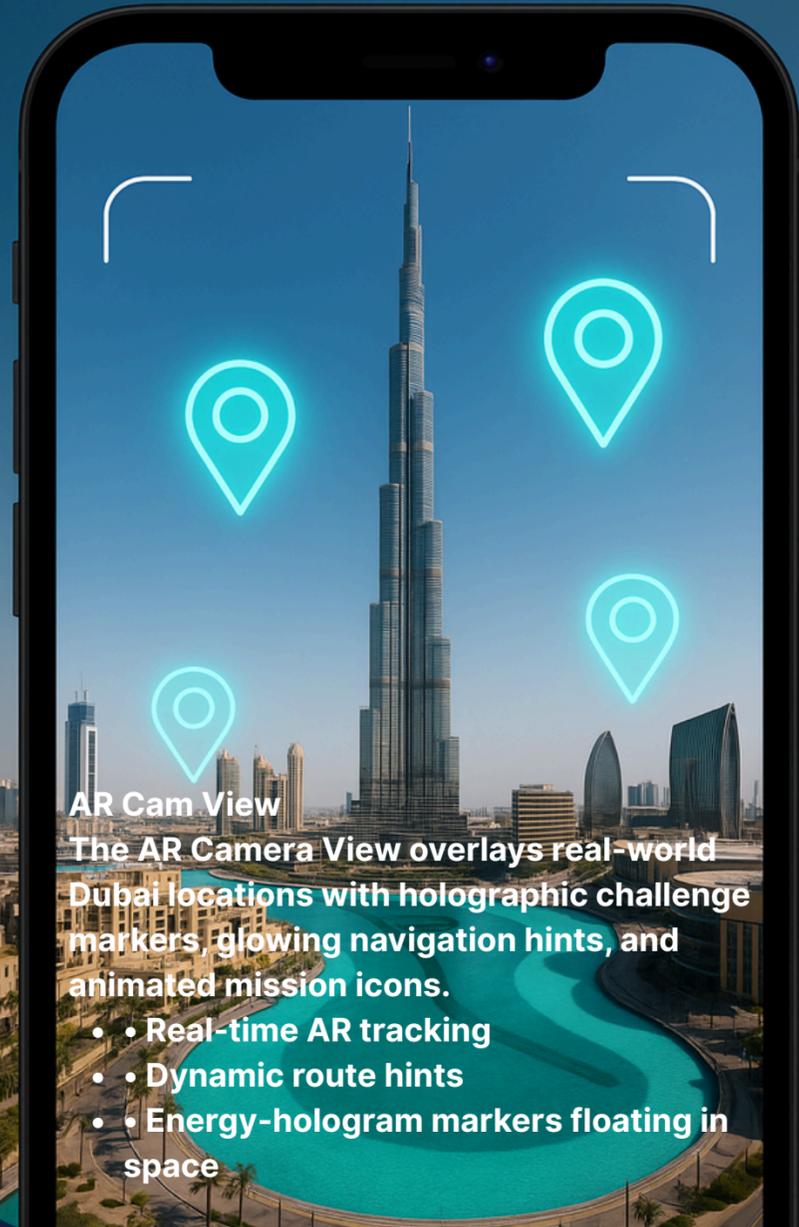
The platform transforms physical destinations into programmable engagement environments using augmented reality (AR) as the interaction layer and analytics as the decision layer.

Unlike standalone AR applications, AURIX operates as structured B2B infrastructure - enabling partners to:

- Measure behavioral movement patterns
- Increase venue dwell time
- Launch monetized engagement campaigns
- Capture structured destination analytics
- Deploy recurring subscription revenue layers

AURIX operates under a hybrid B2B / B2B2C model, with revenue primarily derived from enterprise contracts and venue subscriptions.

2. Market Opportunity

2.1 Industry Context

Global tourism exceeds \$9 trillion annually. Smart destination and digital city transformation spending is accelerating across the UAE and Asia.

Cities increasingly require:

- Behavioral analytics
- Visitor engagement tools
- Data-driven monetization strategies

Yet most tourism ecosystems still measure:

- Foot traffic
- Ticket sales
- Basic heat maps

They lack structured engagement intelligence. AURIX bridges this gap.

3. The Problem

Tourism authorities and venues face structural limitations:

- Limited visibility into visitor behavior
- Inconsistent engagement across districts
- Difficulty monetizing walking traffic
- Fragmented campaign activation tools
- Lack of recurring digital revenue streams

Current solutions are either:

- Social AR filters (non-structured)
- Audio tour apps (non-interactive)
- Data dashboards (non-engaging)
- Event-based activations (temporary)

No unified infrastructure layer exists.

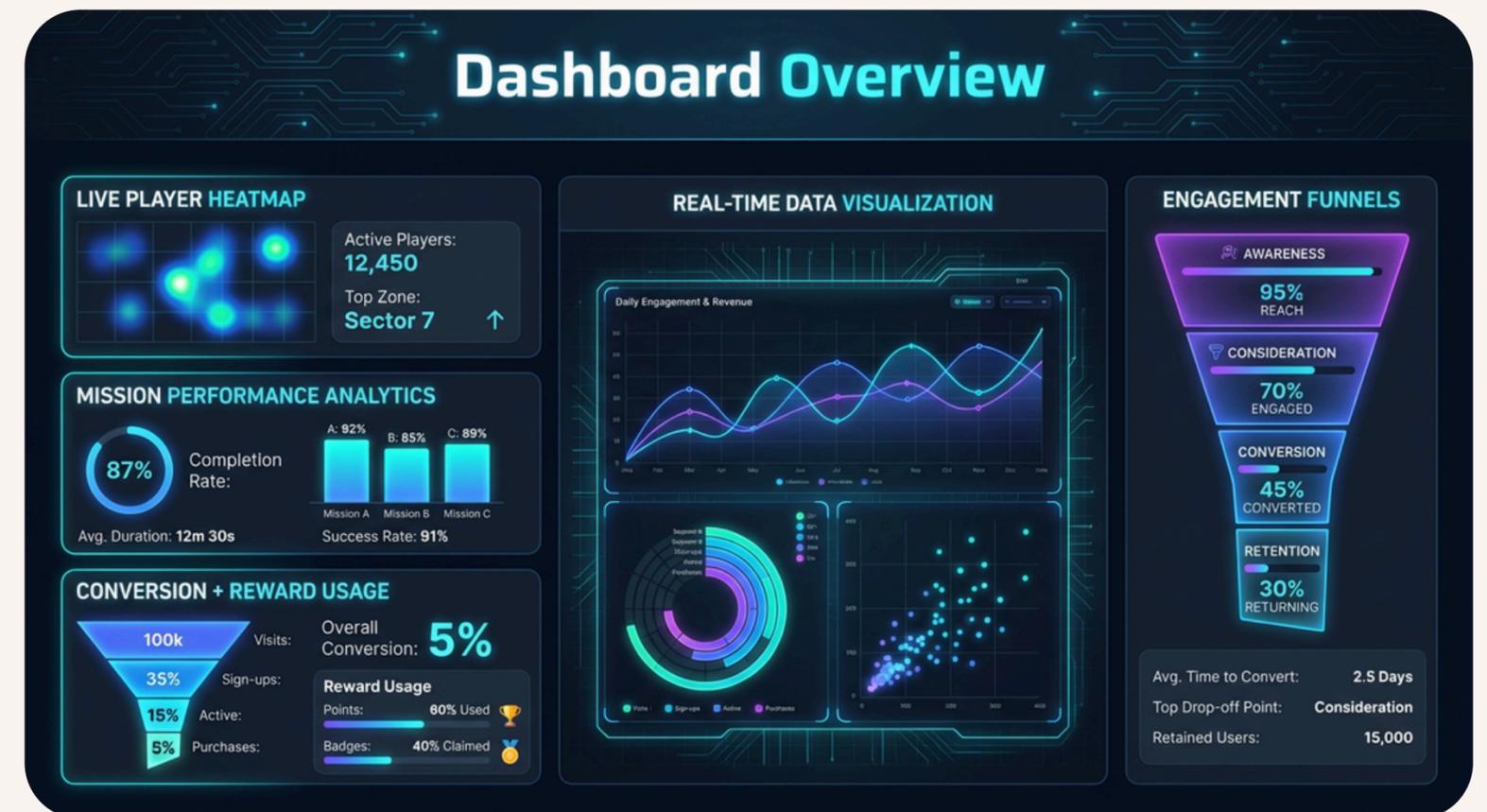
4. The AURIX Solution

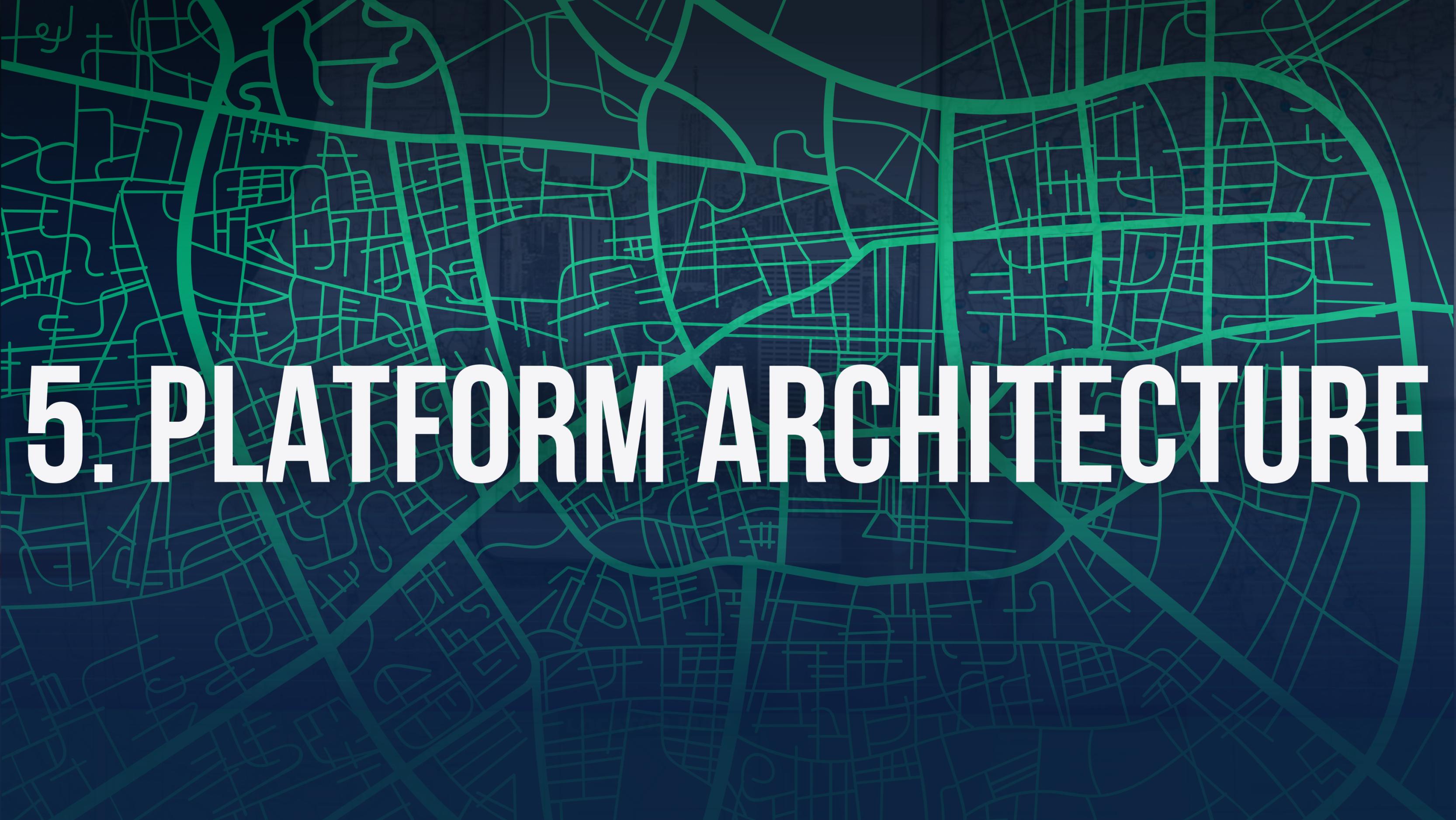
AURIX provides:

Revenue Mix Target (Year 3)

- 70% B2B recurring
- 20% activation campaigns
- 10% B2C premium

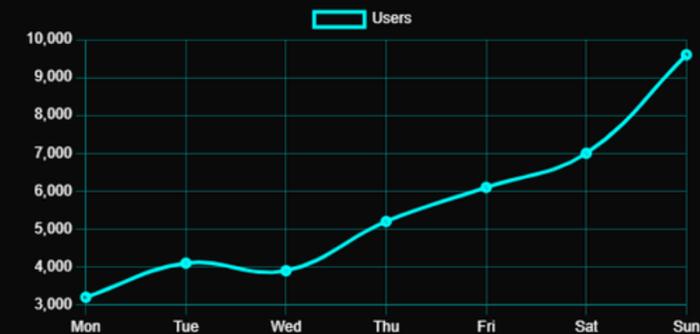

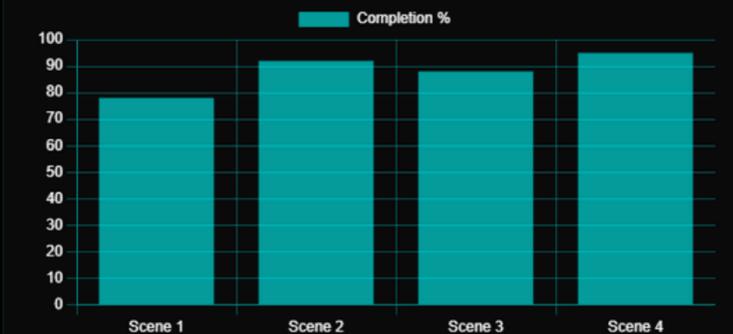

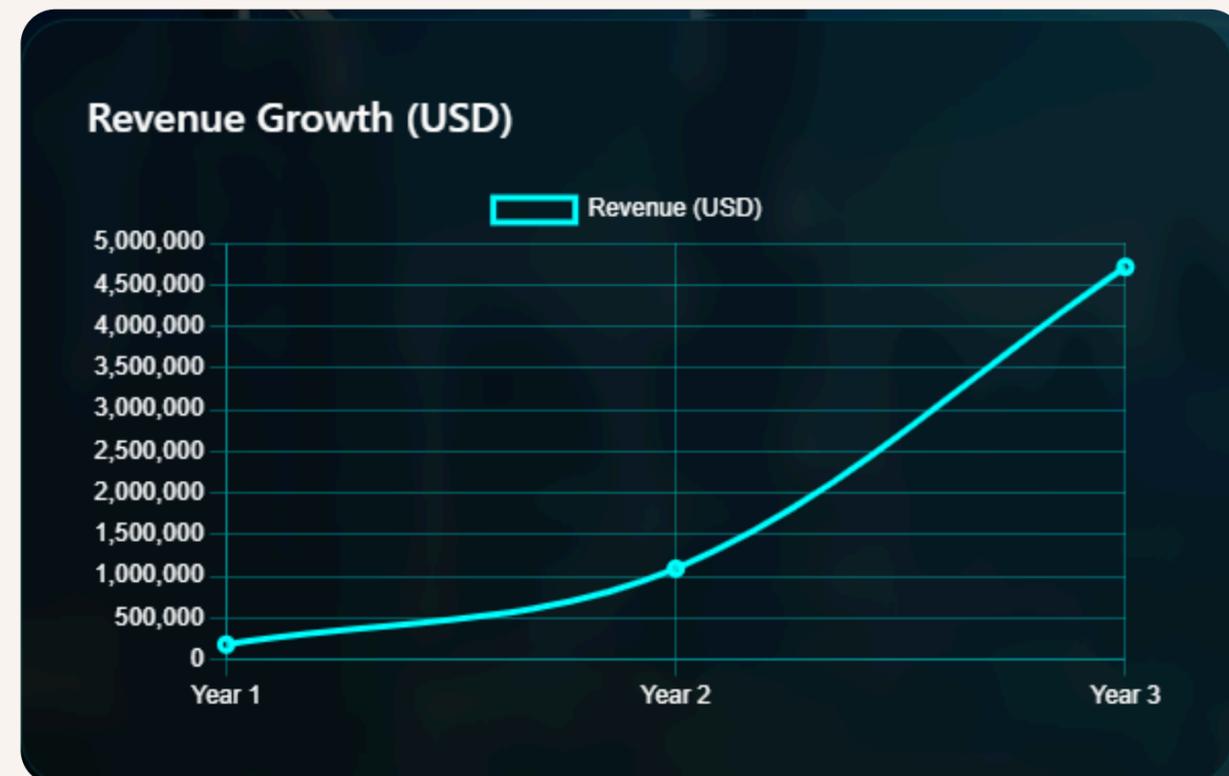
6.1 Revenue Streams

Example: Mid-Size Mall Deployment

- Onboarding cost: \$8k–\$15k
- Monthly SaaS: \$3k average
- 3–6 month payback period
- Target gross margin: 60–70%

Tourist Acquisition (Projected Model)

- Digital install CAC: \$1.50–\$4.00
- Concierge & venue distribution: low CAC
- Organic referral loop via mission sharing

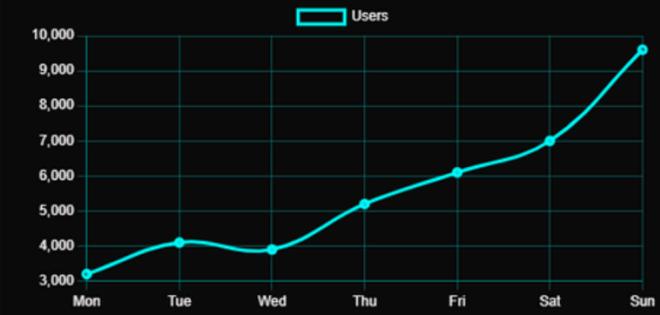

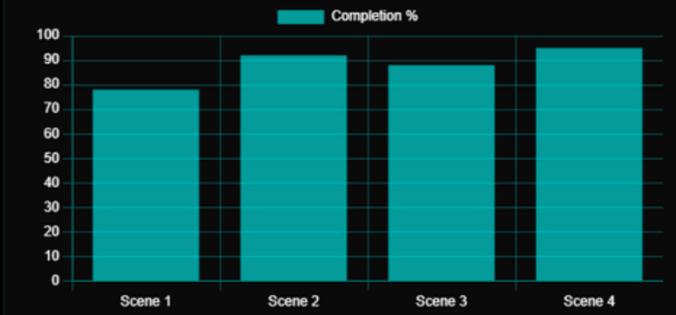

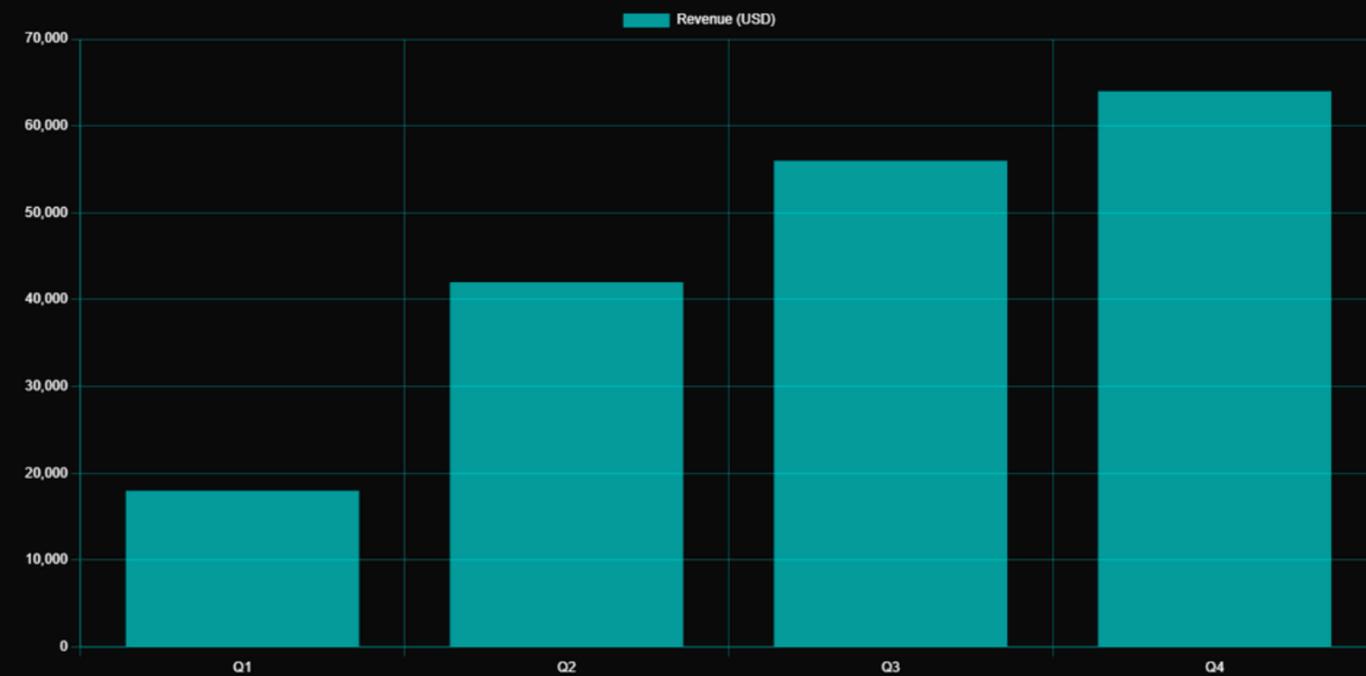
